Are your carbide tips smiling back at you?



Follow these simple steps to do a quick check.



- Is the tip rounded off and smiling back at you? In drier conditions, or in high compaction areas, a rounded off tip can cause poor penetration and lost bushels.
- Does the tip show extreme wear on the sides or above the nose? If so, it could break off and cause holder damage.
- Is there wear showing on the holder? Check for deterioration in hard surfacing and funnels closing in.
